This week we will take a look at God having Joshua divide the land of Canaan among the tribes. We are in chapter 17 of our book.

This week, our scripture reading/reference is only Joshua:

Joshua 12 - 15

This was a difficult reading with all the tribal and geographic cities/area names. But, our focus today is not the actual cities/landscape. We will be looking at:

- A. The timing of the division of the Israelite inheritance
- B. How the decisions were made to distribute the areas of land
- C. The fulfillment of a promise to Caleb
- D. The picture of God "with us" via the tribe of Levi

This Sunday we will approach chapter 17 a little differently than how we have discussed previous chapters and material.

Your assignment is to re-read Keller's chapter 17 and Joshua 12 - 15, and note what you notice/see about the four focus points above. Then come prepared to discuss the key "truths" you have discovered with the rest of the group.

Questions:

- 1. Why did God instruct Joshua to divide the land now? Had Israel finished "possessing" the land?
- 2. Why did Joshua incorporate Eleazer the high priest in the distribution process?
- 3. What did Eleazer do? How do we implement Joshua's strategy in our lives today?
- 4. Why was giving Caleb Mount Hebron so important?
- 5. How does God's provision to the tribe of Levi provide us a picture of God amongst us?
- 6. Why did God allow Canaanites to remain among His people?
- 7. Why is there no word or plan to replace Joshua? God provided a successor for Moses...why not Joshua?
